Vermont Balance of State CoC: January 2017 Point in Time Count of the Homeless Summary

January 2017 PIT Count showed a 19% increase in total persons (149) compared to 2016.

- Sheltered ES/Emergency Shelter Total Persons = 33% increase
- Sheltered TH/Transitional Housing Total Persons = 8% increase
- Unsheltered Total Persons = 13% increase

Reasons for the increase in the number of persons in ES/TH projects:

- Total Persons in GA Motel Program (2017 = 189, 2016 = 106); 78%/83 person increase
- Total Persons in non-AHS Motel Beds (2017 = 36, 2016 = 19); 89%/17 person increase
- New Emergency Shelters funded by HOP and/or GA Alternative: Upper Valley Haven =
 9, GroundWorks = 8, WCYSB = 1, NEKCA-Newport = 10, NEKCA-St. Johnsbury = 3

The following counties experienced a Cold Weather Exception (low eligibilit criteria) on the night of the PIT count, resulting in an increase usage of **GA Motel Program**:

Bennington: 32 for 2017, 2 for 2016
Rutland: 33 for 2017, 39 for 2016
Windham: 40 for 2017, 32 for 2016
Windsor: 21 for 2017, 9 for 2016
Franklin: 2 for 2017, 5 for 2016

• Lamoille had a high number as well: 36 for 2017, 2 for 2016

Reasons for the increase in the number of persons in Unsheltered locations:

- Increased outreach by a few new volunteers to places not meant for human habitation
- Lack of housing units & subsidies
- Insufficient capacity of mental health services

Directly related, but shown separately, Permanent Housing units dedicated to serving the homeless are identified in the Housing Inventory Chart. PH includes Permanent Supportive Housing (Shelter+Care and VASH) and Rapid Rehousing (VRS/AHS-HOP/VA-SSVF/VSHA-CoC):

2017 = 422 in PSH (+10%) and 588 in RRH (+72%); 2016 = 385 in PSH and 341 in RRH
