Housing

- Issues with S+C folks cannot find housing for several months
- Conversation re: access for persons who struggle with housing history
- Misperception that higher rent could garner "better" tenants
- High rent rates could screen out subsidized units
- Value of services
- Comment re: property managers not being trained to support persons with disabilities



 Important to highlight partnerships with housing trusts (Champlain Housing Trust, Addison Housing Trust as partners with service providers) - Vermont Council on Homelessness as resource as well
