### Family Unification Program

Background on the voucher program can be found on this website, <a href="https://dcf.vermont.gov/oeo/partners/FUP">https://dcf.vermont.gov/oeo/partners/FUP</a>.

Resolved, the Vermont Balance of State Board of Directors agrees to assume the following responsibilities regarding the Family Unification Program:

- 1. Work with the Public Child Welfare Agency (PCWA for Vermont, VT Agency of Human Services) to integrate into the coordinated entry process the identification, prioritization, and referral of Family Unification Program -eligible youth not currently within the PCWA's caseload. [Youth who are part of the PCWA's active caseload do not have to be added to the CoC's coordinated entry process.] The CoC should demonstrate how they are assessing the housing and related services needs for youth, and how they come to the determination that a Family Unification Program voucher is the appropriate level of assistance needed;
- 2. Identify services, if any, to be provided using CoC program funds to Family Unification Program eligible families and/or Family Unification Program eligible youth who qualify for CoC program assistance;
- 3. Participate in regular meetings conducted by the Public Housing Authority and PCWA (at least quarterly);
- 4. Upon notification that Family Unification Program vouchers have been awarded, train PHA and PCWA staff on the work of the CoC; and
- 5. Comply with the provisions of the MOU.
