HHAV

- Legislative Update:
 - O Budget Adjustment Act (BAA) Through the rest of the fiscal year (6/30).BAA committee will start working this week. Future of the GA program through June 30th is a major issue. Senate has drafted up who will remain in the program through the remainder of the fiscal year. Current version has a rate cap of 80/day for motels starting March 1; concern about this rate cap causing motels to leave the program. Currently working at the state house to make sure they continue the program in a fashion that keeps most if not all motels in the program with somewhere around 119+/night. Also looking to legislators not divide the cohorts
 - Please send this letter to your legislators
 - Please include something about immediacy and how rate cap will affect your area. Check-in with your staff on-site and with owners to get information directly about how the rate cap will affect your region.
 - O **Be Home Bill**: Tackles lack of affordable housing, shelter capacity, wrap-around services, and high cost of purchasing and rentals. Bill passed out of Senate committee last. Stay tuned for updates.
 - **Homeless Bill of Rights:** Two sections 1. Bill of Rights for persons experiencing homelessness; 2. Extends housing status into VT non-discrimination laws.
 - This bill will be voted out of session but will likely be split in two, with only the second part passing through. HHAV will be working to reunite these two parts of the bill.
 - O Legislation that would tax high-income Vermonters to increase revenue by as much as 500 million to the state annually. Working to minimize opportunities

for people to pit needs of various fields against one another (housing, education, transportation etc.)

- **FY25 Budget Bill** (July 1 June 30)
 - Asks for full funding for GA Program as we work to build sustainable shelter system. Additional service capacity and funding for VHCB & VHFA to promote affordable housing.
